Sir,
 I am directed to refer to your letter No. 3-26/2008/12/1 dated 23.08.2008 and 08.04.2013 on the subject mentioned above. The State Government is requested to furnish the following information/documents:-

(i) The State Government has recommended the proposal under Section 11 (3) of the MMDR Act, 1957, but has not given any comparison of inter-se merits of the all the applicants applied over the subject area. The State Government is requested to furnish comparative chart of all the applicants in the enclosed performa.

(ii) The State Government has also sought relaxation of Rule 59 (1). The State Government is requested to furnish precise reasons in a separate sheet for seeking relaxation of Rule 59 (1).

(iii) The Ministry has issued revised guidelines dated 11.2.2013 for submission of mineral concession proposals. The State Govt. is requested to furnish revised checklist for the instant proposal.
